Authentic Biblical Men:

1. An authentic Biblical man rejects _____

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, Who, though He was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. (Philippians 2:5-8 ESV)



2. An authentic Biblical man accepts _____

"My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of Him Who sent me and to finish His work." (John 4:34)

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her... (Ephesians 5:25)

3. An authentic Biblical man leads ______

"Come, follow Me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people." (Matthew 4:19)

"I am the Good Shepherd. The Good Shepherd lays down His life for the sheep." (John 10:11)

4. An authentic Biblical man invests _____

"Do not store up for yourselves treasures on Earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in Heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal." (Matthew 6:19-20)

Many men will try to do this without God and will find themselves only failing because it is impossible to be this kind of man ______ the Holy Spirit flowing through this man.

Bottom Line: *Men: It is only when we embrace God, trust Him for our salvation, and learn to follow Him as our model for authentic Biblical manhood that we become the kind of man that He intended for us to be.*
